EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

Reunion Hospitality Room: Hotel is providing a dedicated & private hospitality room (the Fiesta Ball Room) with refrigerator for our use from 6:00 AM to 11:45 PM each day. We can stock it with any kind of drink (alcoholic and non) and snacks (no prepared foods). It will have 8 round tables with 8 chairs each and has a drop-down 10 foot projection screen.

Reception Mixer: 26 October 2016. Our initial social gathering for all attendees. Includes a hosted bar service and hors d'oeuvres. Location will be at the hotel in the Tango 4 Ballroom. Will open this to local AMMO troops & spouses. Welcome program with last minute updates provided. Cost covers food and beverages and AV fees.

Hill Country Wine Tour: 27 October 2016. We have reserved a charter bus with Texas Winos that will tour 3 wineries, including wine tasting at each, in the Fredericksburg area as well as leaving everyone to roam/shop the main street of Fredericksburg for about 90 minutes. An Italian lunch is included. We will provide snacks and drinks on the bus enroute. The owner, Richard Wino, has discounted the per person price which includes tax, fees & gratuity. Bus will pick-up participants at the hotel, departing at 10:00 AM and return around 6:00 PM. Bus capacity is 55. If more than 70 sign up for this event, a second bus will be added. This is a 6-7 hour trip. Cost covers transportation, tasting fees, tax & gratuity, snacks and beverages on the bus. Minimum participation is 30.

Lackland Bombdump & USAF Gunsmith Shop Tour: 27 October 2016. We have a 15-passenger rental van that will take folks on a guided tour of the Lackland Bombdump and USAF Gunsmith Shop. Following these stops, the tour will continue with lunch at a favorite Tex-Mex restaurant, shopping and sightseeing around the Alamo City. Cost covers transportation only.

Tour Lackland BMT: 28 October 2016. Participants will be bused to Lackland (56 pax/bus). Planned activities included a private reception at the Pfingston Reception Center, a guided tour of the Airmen's museum, visit BMT areas and having lunch (pay as you go) with Military Training Instructors. Cost covers transportation and food/beverages at reception center.

AMMO Call: 28 October 2016. This event will be open to local AMMO troops in the area. Location will be in the hotel's Fiesta Ballroom (Hospitality room). Self-service bar and snacks provided. We plan to show strike films on a big screen. Cost covers drinks, snacks, and AV fees.

Painting-With-A-Twist: 28 October 2016. Girls night-in (so to speak). Paint your own masterpiece under the tutelage of a local artist during this instructor-led, two hour session while enjoying great company. You'll leave with a one-of-a-kind creation and a new found talent. Drinks and snacks will be provided. Cost covers snacks, beverages, instructor and all painting supplies. Minimum participation is 20.

Golf: 29 October 2016. Scramble-format tournament at Randolph Oaks Golf Course. Participants are transported to/from Randolph AFB and the reunion hotel using a 15-pax rental van and rental cars. Cost includes transportation, lunch, green fees, cart, and team/individual prizes. Premium rental clubs are available for an additional \$12/set. This event is open to local AMMO Troops.

San Antonio Whiskey Distillery and Brewery Tour: 29 October 2016. The Texas Winos will take our participants to two local breweries and one distillery where they will enjoy a VIP tour of each brewery and distillery, learn the craft of beer making, find out how to distinguish between different varieties, be offered tastings at each location, and appreciate this familiar beverage like a true connoisseur. This is a 5-hour bused event. Minimum participation is 30.

Reunion Banquet: 29 October 2016. Held at the hotel in the Tango 3 and 4 ballrooms. This will mark the conclusion of our fantastic week together and is highlighted by a three course dinner with attendees having an entree choice between Chicken Picatta, Grilled Sirloin or Citrus Grilled Salmon. A cash bar will start the evening off on the right (or left) foot. Raffle tickets for door prizes will be sold. The program will include the presentation of colors by the JBSA Color Guard and singing of the National Anthem, a Fallen Chiefs/Comrades table and recognition, presentation of two Shell & Flame Awards, presentation of the Golf Tournament awards, and a DJ to entertain and dance by. A cash bar service will be available following dinner. Cost covers attendees' dinner, DJ, dinner for Honor Guard/Singer, and AV fees.
